Climate Justice Montreal would like to give its public support to Jaggi Singh his actions in organizing the resistance to the Toronto G20 as well as his words given at the fence. The crime of "counselling to commit mischief over \$5000" makes a sham of free speech. CJM hopes to promote just the kind of Justice that Jaggi speaks of, brining an end to global apartheid and regional inequality. In light of the worsening crises of food, water and ecology brought on by climate change we can no longer afford the extravagant greed of the global elite.
